

## **Invisible Speaker Installation and User's Manual**


1. Cut out opening before installing the speaker, make sure speaker cable is exposed and easily to be get access.




3. Select the appropriate shim for the application.




5. Connect speaker cable to the correct speaker terminal.




7. Secure speakers with screws on each side.




2. Peel off corresponding adhesive backing.




4. Press shim firmly into position, algning screw holes.




6. Insert speaker into opening.




8. Fill the gap between speaker and wall with hot mud. Feature all edges.




9. Allow hot mud to set slightly before applying mesh tape.




11. Allow hot mud to fully cure or harden.




13. Feature all the surfaces. Allow the first coat to fully cure or harden.




15. Detail the compound to minimize tool marks. Build more coats as necessary to achieve perfect surface.




10. Mash tape over the wall seams. Overlap tape slight.



12. After hot mud has fully cured or hardened, begin to build layer of compound around the speaker.



14. Start a second coat covering the entire surface, attention that compound buildup on the active surface of the speaker should not exceed 3mm.



16. After final coat is dried, use a manual pole sander on the entire wall. Wall surface should show no signs of the speaker.
